FOOD INSECURITY FACTS

Food insecurity is defined by the USDA as the condition of not having access to sufficient food, or food of an adequate quality, to meet one's basic needs. Food insecurity is rising across the country. Currently, in NW Wisconsin, 1 in 9 adults and 1 in 7 children are food insecure. Food prices are increasing dramatically. Certain food items, e.g., meat, are increasingly hard to obtain. Governments are currently attempting to reduce (or even eliminate) food subsidies for those who are food insecure.

Birchwood Area Food Pantry (BAFP) Facts

The BAFP is a 501 (c) 3 non-profit organization.

The BAFP is 100% staffed by volunteers. There are no paid positions.

The BAFP is 100% funded through private donations. No government funds are

The largest expense (85%) of the BAFP is the cost of food. The remainder of the budget supports the purchase, delivery, storage and distribution of food.
